We plan to include some of our popular activities and events for the 2023-24 year including family activity evenings, Adult gatherings and student participation/ministries at Sunday Mass.

1. The Wednesday evening class time will be from 6:45-8:00pm.
2. Classes will be held on Wednesdays, beginning **October 4th** and ending **the final Wed. of April, 2024**.
3. The curriculum from "Faith and Life" will be used in grades 1 through 9; gr. 10/11 will be Confirmation preparation.
4. We **expect that parents help throughout the year**, serving in the capacity of room/safety monitors, helping in the office, etc. We welcome all parents to assist with our program on Wednesdays.
5. Rather than ask you to pay tuition, you are encouraged to contribute a monetary amount for each child registered in the program. The suggested donation is **\$40.00** for the first child, **\$35.00** for the second child and **\$30.00** for the third child. For those with 4 or more children, we suggest a donation of **\$100.00**. Any donation you can make is appreciated. No one will be denied Faith Formation classes, regardless of contributions.
6. **Sacrament Preparation:** In the First Reconciliation and First Eucharist programs, parents will prepare their child. We give you materials and guidance to assist you as you help your child in learning more about their faith. The Confirmation program is a part of our 10th/11th Grade Wednesday evening program and uses the guidelines from the Diocese.
7. We do have safe environment training, as directed by our Diocese, for ALL of our students, teachers and volunteers. Parents are welcome to preview the materials.
8. It is very important that parents show the example of Christian life to their children at home: prayer life, moral life, attendance at Mass, use of the Sacraments, service to those in need. We will do our best to assist you so your children may have the best possible training in the Catholic Faith.
