Any donation you can make is appreciated. No one will be denied Faith Formation classes, regardless of contributions.
- **6. Sacrament Preparation:** In the First Reconciliation and First Eucharist programs, parents wil1 prepare their child. We give you materials and guidance to assist you as you help your child in learning more about their faith. The Confirmation program is a part of our 10th/11th Grade Wednesday evening program and uses the guidelines from the Diocese.
- 7. We do have safe environment training, as directed by our Diocese, for ALL of our students, teachers, and volunteers. Parents are welcome to preview the materials.
- 8. It is especially important that parents show the example of Christian life to their children at home: prayer life, moral life, attendance at Mass, use of the Sacraments, service to those in need. We will do our best to assist you so your children may have the best possible training in the Catholic Faith.
